

DAYLILY SHOW

DESIGN DIVISION - GENERAL RULES 2017

1. The Design Division will be judged by flower show judges Accredited by The National Garden Clubs, Inc. The Standard System of Awarding will be used. 1 blue ribbon per class, must score 90 or more; 1 red ribbon scoring 85 or more; 1 yellow ribbon scoring 80 or more; and one or more white ribbons scoring 75 or more
2. All designs must be the work of one exhibitor, and placed by That exhibitor.
3. Daylilies must be DOMINANT in ALL arrangements.
4. An exhibitor may fill only one entry in a class, but may enter more than one class.
5. All entries in the Design Division are to be pre-registered and spaces will be reserved by the committee.
6. Plant material used should be listed on a 3"x5" card. A separate card of explanation may be used.
7. Tables and pedestals will be furnished by the show committee. Backgrounds will be furnished where noted in the schedule. Bases and accessories are permitted in all classes.
8. Plant material used need not have been grown by the exhibitor. No artificial plant material is permitted.
9. The top Design entry must have scored 95 points or above to Receive the top Award.
10. The Design Division must have three classes with four entries in each class to qualify for the top AHS award.
11. The Winning exhibitor of the top award must be a member of AHS or join at the show.
12. No live animals are permitted.
13. Landscapes or scenes are not permitted in Design Division.
