

DAYLILY SHOW GENERAL RULES 2017

1. Exhibition is open to all daylily growers. Each entry must have been grown, groomed and entered by the exhibitor.
2. **Only AHS members are eligible to win AHS Rosettes** and other AHS sponsored awards. Members may be new members who join during the show.
3. All entries will be received (acknowledged by Classification Committee) between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Saturday, June 3, 2014 at Lake Terrace Convention Center. Late entries arriving after 10:30 a.m. may be entered **FOR DISPLAY ONLY** and will not be judged. No entry may be removed before 4:00 p.m. Exhibits not removed shortly after 5:00 p.m. will be destroyed. Ribbons or awards not claimed at this time will be made available to the exhibitor at a later date.
4. The Show Committee will furnish uniform containers and AHS Show entry tags.
5. **ONLY MEMBERS OF THE PLACEMENT COMMITTEE ARE PERMITTED TO PLACE ENTRIES IN THE DISPLAY AREA.**
6. Judging will begin promptly at 10:45 a.m. Only Judges, Clerks, Show Chairman, Judges Chairman, Classification Chairman and Photographer will be allowed in the exhibition area during judging.
7. Show officials and Hattiesburg Area Daylily Society will exercise all precautions for protecting exhibits but neither they nor Lake Terrace Convention Center or any of its agents will be responsible for loss or damage that may occur. In addition to these General Rules, the "Show Schedule" contains more detailed information relative to: Show Committees, Show Horticultural Rules, Show Judges Rules, Show Design Rules, Show Division I, Show Design, Show Awards, Junior Judge Certification, Show Scale of Points, and Show Special Awards. The Show Schedule will be available at the Information Desk at the Show, and when exhibitors arrive to enter their daylilies.

Groups A-Z

Section 4: Registered Miniature Flowers less than 3”
Groups A-Z

Class A Large Flower 4 ½” or more

Class 1. Five scapes—different registered cultivars
Class 2. Five scapes—different seedlings

Section 13: The Earl Watts Award
One scape of a LARGE RED registered cultivar.

Section 14. The Nell George Award
One scape of a SMALL OR MINIATURE registered
cultivar.

Section 15: The Mary Lois Burkett Award

One scape of a LARGE SPIDER TYPE registered cultivar
(Does not have to be on the Spider Flowers List)

Section 16: The Louise Cubley Award

One scape of a LARGE PINK registered cultivar.

Section 17: The Marty DeBolt Award

One scape of a LARGE GOLDEN YELLOW registered cultivar.

DIVISION II: HORTICULTURE OFF-SCAPE

Section I: Debutante: Any size, form, color or pattern
cultivar registered 2011- 2015. Must be listed
in the AHS *HEMEROCALLIS CHECK LIST* .
